AS MATHEMATICIANS WE ARE....

...learning about: place value, addition, subtraction and shapes this term.

AS READERS AND WRITERS....

...we will be creating our own stories based upon 'Kipper's Toy Box'. We will be creating information documents about toys and giraffes. We will also be creating poetry about winter.

AS INVESTIGATORS WE ARE.....

SCIENCE: An introduction to **Everyday Materials.** The children describe their properties and compare and group them based upon this. All within the purposeful context of our toys study.

AS ENQUIRERS WE ARE.....
