AS MATHEMATICIANS WE ARE....

Developing our work with the four operations: addition; subtraction; multiplication; division. This will extend into problem solving. We will also be studying place value, length and perimeter.

AS READERS AND WRITERS....

We will be writing to entertain with two units. One about the Tudors and a further one based upon *The Secret Garden*.
We will then be writing to instruct as we create instructions for our Tudor houses.
We will then finish with a persuasive writing unit.

AS INVESTIGATORS WE ARE.....

SCIENCE: We will be studying teeth and the digestive system during this term and applying our knowledge and findings to advise the Tudors during a 'mock' theme day called: Digestion Day.

AS ENQUIRERS WE ARE.....

GEOGRAPHY: A human geography study to build upon the Year 3 physical geography studies. Looking at trade links, economic activity, type of settlement and land use at the time.

HISTORY: We will study life in Britain from the end of the War of the Roses in 1485. Considering life after this period and its major figures who shaped the actions and events that followed including the Spanish Armada.

RELIGIOUS EDUCATION: We will be studying the Jewish faith this term and the ways in which they maintain their relationship with God. We will also be asking what is the most significant part of the Nativity story for Christians.

AS COMMUNICATORS WE ARE.....

COMPUTING: Using text and multimedia to communicate with an audience (a quiz for peers) using a presentation programme - with a particular focus upon links and timings within animations, transitions and a Tudor theme..

FRENCH: Learning different ways to introduce yourself to others and then studying language for the seasons.
