BUSY CURRICULUM UPGRADES & EXTERNAL CHALLENGE

During the last two weeks, we have asked external professionals to come into school and take a look at our curriculum. We are constantly making tweaks and updating our methods, coverage and approaches. Therefore it is important we ask for professionals outside of school to come and assess our position and provide that challenge and accountability when we make updates to our provision. This work will continue aross the next two terms and our school training days and late night Wednesday sessions are focused upon upgrading our planning and knowledge work in all subject areas to ensure that it fits our children's needs as tightly as possible. Basically we are giving it everything in order to constantly improve and find more from what we teach. Just because we are in a good place does not mean that we should stop there. We always aim for better. curriculum and our constant strive to make it better, upgrade it and seek that expert external scrutiny that drives us forward. I am hoping that I will soon be in a position to tell you more about the major upgrades once they reach completion. The curriculum is one of the most exciting parts of the job as a teacher. Working out what we are going to teach and how we are going to do it lights me up as a teacher. Bringing it to life is the icing on the cake. ATTENDANCE UPDATES

Attendance sits at 95.98% which is well above national averages. Thank you to everyone in school who has that high school attendance - remember 96% or better is the minimum that we aim for in school for every child.
