ATTENDANCE UPDATES FOR NOVEMBER

As you would expect, the government expects us to regularly update everyone and report upon attendance progress. We use our Don't Miss A Minute campaign and are using a monthly update this year after our initial OCTOBER version.

Attendance remains very good in school during NOVEMBER. Our initial aim would always be to ensure we are at least in line with national averages and our aspiration is to be beyond this figure and hit our own ambitious target of 96%.

96% is definitely a reasonable goal for every child and family. It allows for genuine absence and does not expect perfection and is attainable for all. I am pleased that many families meet or exceed this 96% at Mayfield.

Our headline figures at Mayfield remain above all national comparisons which is excellent news. I would particularly like to thank my multi-agency team at school who remain focused on attendance matters and keep offering those messages and prompts (sometimes necessarily strong messages) to families who do not take attendance as seriously as the majority.

We are required to monitor the attendance of children within what the government call a 'disadvantaged' group largely, but not exclusively, formed of families who receive free school meals (amongst other criteria). There are alarming trends nationally between low attendance and children within this group. Fortunately, our attendance is very good for this group but it is a major national focus and concern.

Lastly, well done to MR TAYLOR'S CLASS who have received 3 of the 5 weekly attendance awards in November. Earning three of the five available non-uniform Mondays.
