A FIRST CHOICE SCHOOL

I wanted to start the update by sharing some important news about school and its popularity with you all. The lower birth rate in the area is meaning that places in schools across the region are more available than at peak times and almost all schools are feeling this pinch in terms of new starters, however we have completely bucked that trend and are over-subscribed for new starters into Early Years in September 2025. This means there are more people wanting to come than are

<u>able to be allocated places due to demand.</u> This continues to match our amazing in-year intake numbers across school. It is so important that school is in high standing in the local area and most specifically for our unique and innovative learning offer and approach. It is a huge source of pride that families are streaming towards our school as their first choice and this has been noticed by senior council figures who have congratulated us on our success as a school. I said on the website

when I started at Mayfield in 2019, that we would change the landscape and alter perspectives. We have done just that. We will continue to do that. Our methods and approaches fit the needs of learners in our community and we are immensely proud that this is shown in the sheer number of families choosing us as their first choice.

PARENT FORUM

Lots to update you on as we approach half-term holidays. Firstly, we undertook our first Parent Forum of 2025 last week.
